Want your child to do well? Attendance Matters...

How does attendance affect outcomes for pupils?

Being in school is important to your child's achievement, wellbeing, and wider development. <u>Evidence</u> shows that the students with the highest attendance throughout their time in school gain the best GCSE and A Level results.

Our research found that pupils who performed better both at the end of primary and <u>secondary school</u> missed fewer days than those who didn't perform as well.

The data also shows that in 2019, <u>primary school</u> children in Key Stage 2 who didn't achieve the expected standard in reading, writing and maths missed on average four more days per school year than those whose performance exceeded the expected standard.

Similarly, in the same year, secondary school pupils who didn't achieve grade 9 to 4 in English and maths missed on 10 more


