

Key stage 2 comparative report

This information allows you to compare your child's performance at the end of key stage 2 with the attainment of other year 6 pupils in our school and across England.

Please bear in mind when looking at the school figures, that there were only 8 children in the Y6 cohort which means each child was worth 12.5%.

Children that are disapplied from the test because, for example, they may have additional needs, and they are unable to access the test are still counted towards this data with a zero score.

The government recognise that small cohort sizes create data abnormalities, and do not enter schools with 8 or less pupils into league tables for this reason.
